**Participation of Embassy of India and six India companies in the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of  
the Instituto Politecnico's Nacional's (IPN) Internationalization Forum**

The 2023 edition of the Internationalization Forum at the Instituto Politécnico Nacional (IPN), one of the leading institutions of higher education in Mexico, took place on June 28, 29 and 30, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., at Plaza Lázaro Cárdenas and Centro Cultural Jaime Torres Bodet, at the Unidad Profesional Adolfo López Mateos (Zacatenco).

The Embassy of India in Mexico City along with the Gurudev Tagore Indian Cultural Center (GTICC) had a grand India Pavilion at the 2nd edition of the Internationalization Forum, where textiles, handicrafts, furniture, musical instruments, books and videos of India were showcased. Thousands of students, professors and dignitaries visited the Pavilion wishing to learn more about India as a country, about its culture, tourism and opportunities for students to study in India. The Pavilion also had information regarding the classes held by the GTICC in Mexico.

Ambassador Pankaj Sharma, during his remarks at the inaugural event, highlighted the Indian ethos and traditions flowing from the global outlook of India from ancient times, as also reflected in the Indian motto of Vasudhaiv Kutumbkam i.e., the entire world is one family. He recalled that India prides in being the home to the oldest international university of Nalanda, founded in 425 AD that housed more than a million books from all over the world. Ambassador Sharma invited the dignitaries, authorities and the student community of IPN, to know more about India and the great opportunities it offers to the youth.

In continuation of the celebrations of the 9<sup>th</sup> International Yoga Day, two special Yoga sessions were organized at the Jaime Torres Bodet Cultural Centre (IPN), where the IPN community participated in the Yoga classes and learned the benefits of practicing this traditional discipline.

5. The six Indian companies which participated in this event and put their stands included HCL tech, UPL Ltd, JK Tornel, Bajaj Auto, Indorama ventures Ltd., and Un Dos Tres. All the companies displayed their capabilities and product strengths, with Bajaj and JK Tornel also displaying their motorcycles and tyres respectively.

6. IPN students were also given information pertaining to ICCR as well as other Government of India scholarships, which were well received by the talented young community at IPN.
