Dear Friends,

The month of April was an eventful one, with the successful conclusion of the visit of Hon'ble Foreign Minister of Mexico H.E. Mr. Marcelo Ebrard to India. The latter part of the month was devoted to the follow-up of the visit and implementation of the outcomes. We have a number of MoU's in pipeline which I will share with you in the forthcoming issues as we make progress in that regard.

In order to promote people-to-people links, we are focusing on promoting tourism, cultural exchanges and exchanges between students and youth. One important aspect is increasing the academic collaboration between top Mexican and Indian Universities. In this regard, we are about to start a 'Distinguished Lecture Series' on various topics of interest by inviting academicians, think tanks and field experts from two countries. We already have prestigious Universities such as the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), Autonomous University of the State of Hidalgo (UAEH) and Tecnológico de Monterrey (TEC) from Mexico as our partners. Indian Universities such as Jawaharlal Nehru University, Indian Institute of Management in Jammu, think tanks such as Manohar Parrikar Institute for Defence Studies and Analyses (MP-IDSA) and various experts, bureaucrats, businesspersons from India will be part of this initiative. It would be one of a kind confluence of knowledge, expertise and experience between India and Mexico.

The Festival of India at Centro Nacional de la Artes (CENART) concluded on a successful note. It was a historic event which witnessed an outstanding response from the people of Mexico. I would like to congratulate Director of our Indian Culture Centre Dr. Shrimati Das and her team who successfully captured and showcased essence of India to people of Mexico during this month long festival. Saree and textile exhibition, bollywood movie screening, Indian Bazaar and cultural performance were highlights of the event.

Finally, let me take this opportunity to highlight the fact that the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi had set an ambitious target of \$400 billion of goods exports by India for the year 2021-22 & we achieved this target for the first time ever. It is a historic feat considering that we are only coming out of the shadow of COVID-19 pandemic. Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated our farmers, weavers, MSMEs, manufacturers on this achievement and called it as an important step towards 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' (Self-Reliant India).

I hope that we can leverage India's strengths and expand the successful trade relations with Mexico - our important trade partner in Latin America. I had an opportunity to call on the Economy Minister of Mexico H.E. Ms. Tatiana Clouthier in April and discuss various ways in which we can increase India-Mexico commercial relations and address the underlying bottlenecks.

Several activites and events are lined up in the coming weeks. We hope that you can join us in these endeavours.





Alcaldía Miguel Hidalgo successfully organized the very impressive first touristic national sport of México Charreada Turística Miguel Hidalgo.







Dr.Sanjaya Rajaram

Dr. Sanjaya Rajaram (1943–2021) was an Indian-born Mexican scientist and winner of the 2014 World Food Prize. He was awarded this prize for his scientific research in developing 510+ wheat varieties that have been released in 51 countries. This innovation has led to an increase in world wheat production – by more than 200 million tons – building upon the successes of the Green Revolution.

The Government of India awarded him the highest civilian awards Padma Shri (2001) and Padma Bhushan (2022). He was also awarded the prestigious World Food Prize in 2014 for his role in increasing global wheat production and alleviating world hunger.

In 2015, he was awarded the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman award, the highest honor conferred on Indians overseas by the Government of India. He also received numerous fellowships from scientific societies and doctorates from various universities.
