State in Focus - Madhya Pradesh



Madhya Pradesh is located in central India. The state is bound on the north by Uttar Pradesh, on the east by Chhattisgarh, on the south by Maharashtra, and on the west by Gujarat and Rajasthan. It is among the fastest growing states in the country. At current prices, the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) of Madhya Pradesh is estimated at Rs.1,151,049 crore trillion (US\$ 150.74 billion) in 2022-23, registering an annual growth of 10% over FY21. Between 2015-16 and 2021-22, The GSDP increased at a CAGR (in Rs.) of 13.09% from 2015-16 to 2021-22. Net State Domestic Product (NSDP) of Madhya Pradesh was about Rs. 8.27 trillion (US\$ 113.94 billion) in 2020-21. Between 2015-16 and 2020-21, state's NSDP grew at a CAGR of around 11.22%.

Madhya Pradesh is rich in natural resources - fuel, minerals, agriculture, and biodiversity. It is also the only diamond producing state in the country. Diamond production in the state stood at 38,437 carats in 2018-19. Madhya Pradesh offers distinctive monetary and strategy/policy incentives for organizations under the Industrial Promotion Policy-2014 other than strategies/policies for information technology (IT), biotechnology, tourism, and special economic zone (SEZs). To pull in investors and promote entrepreneurs, the State Government has selected TRIFAC, an agency that encourages a single window system, for speedy approvals of different clearances and consents.

Exports from the state stood at US\$ 3,770.08 million in FY23 (until August 2022). According to the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), cumulative FDI inflow in Madhya Pradesh was valued at US\$ 508.98 million between October 2019- June 2022.

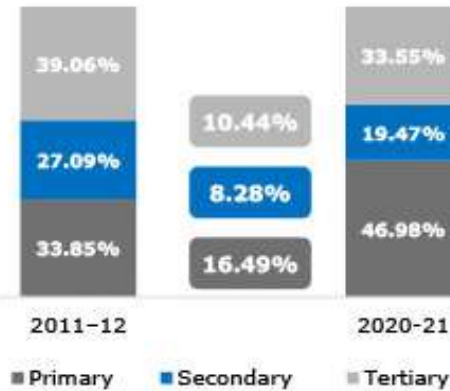

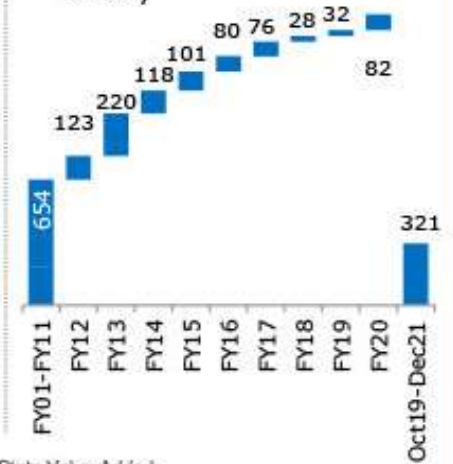
GSDP of Madhya Pradesh at Current Prices

Strategically located business hub

Centrally located state in India. Major consumer goods multinationals are situated in Madhya Pradesh in order to access major consumer markets and metro urban communities.

State has a well-developed automotive cluster and is home to around 30 auto component and ancillary units.

At labour costs of US\$ 3.7 per day, the state has a significant cost advantage over metros.

The state houses some of the country's most reputed institutes including Indian Institute of Management, Indian Institute of Foreign Management and Indian Institute of Technology.

Madhya Pradesh Industrial Development Corporation (MPIDC) has emerged as the leading investment promotion agency worldwide. In the field of investment promotion, the state scored 97%.



Policy and infrastructure support

In August 2022, Mr. Nitin Gadkari, Minister of Road Transport & Highways inaugurated and laid foundation stone of 6 National Highway projects of 119 kms worth Rs. 2,300 crore (US\$ 279.18 million) in Indore, Madhya Pradesh.

State introduced the 'Madhya Pradesh Health Sector Investment Promotion Scheme 2020' to encourage private investment in healthcare infrastructure by incentivising the establishment of standalone healthcare centres.
