Press Release: Press meet with Mexican print and electronic media and PR agencies for highlighting the results of the NFHS-6

Mexico City, June 19, 2026

The Embassy of India in Mexico City hosted a press meet with the participation of representatives from leading Mexican media organisations and prominent public relations agencies to highlight the key findings of the sixth edition of India's National Family Health Survey (NFHS-6) and share insights into India's development journey.
