EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION OF PASSENGER FLIGHTS TO AND FROM INDIA FOR A FURTHER PERIOD OF TWO WEEKS WITH EFFECT FROM 4 MAY 2020

The Government of India, in continuance with the measures being taken to contain the spread of the coronavirus, has decided to extend the ban on all scheduled international commercial passenger services for a further period of two weeks till 17 May, 2020. The decision has been taken after a comprehensive review of the Lockdown measures leading to significant gains in the country.

2. In view of the above, we urge the entire Indian community and all stranded Indians in Mexico and Belize to kindly stay put safely in your place of stay and observe all the ‘social distancing’ protocols as advised by the local authorities. All are requested to maintain caution and ascertain verified information only through the government sources. ***“Say No to Panic, Yes to Precaution”!***
