IN FOCUS: Visit of Foreign Minister of Mexico H.E. Mr.Marcelo Ebrard to India





Ambassador of India Mr. Pankaj Sharma

I am happy to connect with fellow readers through this important medium of our monthly newsletter. I came to Mexico as Ambassador of India only two months ago, but this time has been sufficient for me to feel the warmth of its people and to realize the great similarities between India and Mexico, starting from our rich civilizational heritages, vibrant culture and traditions, along with the vast potential of collaboration and cooperation that our countries hold.

With more than 1.3 billion people today, India, the second most populous country is the sixth largest economy in the world with a great business environment for facilitating businesses and investments as well as supporting innovation and startups.

India remembers Mexico for its help with the green revolution as well as for some of the Mexico's finest diplomats, like Mr. Octavio Paz, who warmly wrote about India and introduced India to Mexicans. India and Mexico share a close and cordial relationship based on respect and mutual understanding. It is heartening to see Indian culture, art, philosophy, spirituality, yoga and Bollywood, highly appreciated by Mexicans. The ongoing Festival of India at CENART is being well received attracting huge crowds.

Our bilateral relations have gone from strength to strength with every passing year, which is reflected in the visits by both our Foreign Ministers within a span of six months. Hon ble External Affairs Minister of India Dr. S. Jaishankar visited Mexico in September 2021 and we had the honor of receiving Hon ble Foreign Minister of Mexico Mr. Marcelo Ebrard in India from 30 March 2022-01 April 2022.

Even as our privileged partnership grows further, we are exploring new avenues for enhancing this to a strategic partnership, as agreed by our leadership at the highest level. We are now working on a road map to define the strategic partnership. We are looking at new and exciting areas of cooperation such as, co-production of vaccines and medicines, cooperation in Ayurveda and other traditional systems of medicine, higher education, science and technology, including project accelerators, research and development, innovation and outer space etc.

Mexico has become our second largest trading partner in the entire Latin American region and in fact the third in all of the Americas. In 2021, the bilateral trade between India and Mexico crossed US \$ 10 Billion. However, there is huge untapped potential and we at the Embassy are striving to enhance trade and investments between India and Mexico.

Our two countries enjoy strong institutional foundation cemented through several cooperation agreements in numerous areas like culture, tourism promotion, agriculture, education, space cooperation, technologies, small scale industries, renewable energy, air services, customs, just to name a few, and there are many more in the pipeline. In the international context likewise, our countries have similar positions on most of the global challenges and issues.

We continue to enjoy each other's support in international forums and are working together at the United Nations Security Council as non-permanent members since 1st of January, 2021. India knows that it has a good friend in Mexico. Similarly Mexico also finds a a close and reliable partner in India.

India currently hosts the third largest ecosystem for new companies worldwide, with the plans of Startup India and Make in India, as well as the India Innovation Growth Program 2.0. There are many opportunities, that I would encourage the Mexican investors and businesses to take advantage of.

We fondly remember Mexico for being the first country in Latin America to establish diplomatic relations with India, soon after attaining its independence in August 1947, and today after 71 years, this friendship has only deepened and strengthened.

We look forward to working together with our friends in Mexico in taking forward this important relationship.





Boosting investments and trade opportunities and cooperation in the framework of G-20 were the main themes of discussions. (30 March 2022)

They looked at the opportunities for enhancing India – Mexico space collaboration, beyond the space agency level.

FM Ebrard held a meeting with Mr. Parag Deshmukh from the Serum Institute of India which supplied Covishield vaccine to Mexico. It was agreed to jointly work on vaccine production and supplies in future.



Political In Focus-Establishment of India-Mexico Parliamentary Friendship Group



The Mexico-Republic of India Friendship Group was officially inaugurated on 23 March, 2022 at the Chamber of Deputies of Mexico. The occasion saw the presence of Ambassador of India to Mexico Dr. Pankaj Sharma, President of the Parliamentary Friendship Group, Deputy H.E. Salvador Caro Cabrera; the two Vice-Presidents of the Parliamentary Friendship Group, Deputy H.E. Ms. Lidia Perez Barcenas and Deputy H.E. Mr. Manuel Guillermo Chapman Moreno and other Hon'ble Members of the Friendship Group.



Ambassador Pankaj Sharma also called on the Vice President of the Chamber of Deputies, H.E. Ms. Karla Almazan. Ms. Almazán congratulated India on the launching of the México-India Parliamentary Friendship Group & extended support of the Chamber of Deputies to the Group. (25 March 2022)

Ambassador Pankaj Sharma in his remarks noted that parliamentary ties between India and Mexico are a cornerstone of the deep and wide-ranging Privileged Partnership between the two countries, which complement several other regular institutional engagements at the higher political levels. He mentioned that the signing of the Constitutive act of the Parliamentary Friendship Group between India and Mexico was taking place at a time when the relations between the two Governments and people are at their best. While referring to the upcoming visit of Hon'ble Foreign Minister of Mexico H.E. Marcelo Ebrard to India, Ambassador Sharma remarked that the visit would help in taking our bilateral relations forward with a renewed vigour.

President of the Friendship Group Mr. Cabrera affirmed that there is strong interest in strengthening ties of friendship between both countries as well as desire to receive Parliamentarians from India for further strengthening of bilateral relations.

Vice-President of the Friendship Group, Deputy H.E. Ms. Lidia Perez Barcenas and Deputy H.E. Mr. Manuel Guillermo Chapman Moreno highlighted the strong ties that both nations share and touched upon the continuing engagements in culture, education, trade, commerce, health, science and technology. They also underscored the importance of this Friendship Group mechanism in deepening political dialogue and the bilateral and multilateral cooperation.

The Friendship Groups in the Lower House (Chamber of Deputies) in Mexico are legislative committees whose purpose is to draw attention and provide follow-up on bilateral agendas with Legislative Assemblies, Congresses, Parliaments and other bodies of popular representation of countries with which Mexico maintains diplomatic relations.
