



30 Indian companies to participate in Intermoda 2019

30 Indian exporters from textiles and fashion industry would be participating in Intermoda, Guadalajara from 15 to 18 January, 2019 at Expo Guadalajara under the banner of Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) funded by Ministry of Commerce, Government of India. The items on display would include men, women and children's wear, swim wears, carpets, leather bags, hand-embroidered textiles, skin and body care products, synthetic fibre, work wear and summer collection for 2019. The Indian pavilion will extend from stall no. 9078 to 10085.

Indian companies have been participating regularly in InterModa every year with 30-40 companies. In terms of exports from India to Mexico, India is the 4th biggest exporter of apparels and clothing accessories. In the period of January-September India exported goods worth 84 million USD registering a growth of 23 percent. In 2017, India exported goods worth 101 million USD in total.

India's textiles sector is one of the oldest industries in Indian economy dating back several centuries. India's overall textile exports during FY 2017-18 stood at US\$ 39.2 billion. The Indian textiles industry, currently estimated at around USD 150 billion, is expected to reach USD 250 billion by 2019. India's textiles industry contributed seven per cent of the industry output (in value terms) of India in 2017-18. It contributed two per cent to the GDP of India and employs more than 45 million people in 2017-18. The production of raw cotton in India is estimated to have reached 34.9 million bales annually. (Indian FY runs from April to March).
